- Title of the Workshop, Workshop Acronym
- Technical Program: Please include (but not limited to) the following details:
- Abstract, main topics, invited or keynote speakers, hands-on session(s), panel discussion (optional), a tentative list of PC Members (optional), poster presentation (optional).
- Topics that will be covered: Describe the topics that will be covered in the workshop.
- Broader impact statement: Describe why the workshop is relevant to the community and how relevant the topics or discussion are to the UPCON audience.
- Relationship to previous workshops (if any): Describe how this proposal relates to previous workshops including participation statistics. Duration of the workshop (Half Day/Full Day)
- Expected number of participants (please specify the Minimum and Maximum number of expected attendees), Registration fee, plan for advertisement, and Budget for the workshop
- Organizing team's experience and background: Information that supports the organizers' ability to run a workshop, and appropriateness to a workshop on the chosen topic. Include brief bios for the main organizers.
- Any other information (e.g., Infrastructure/logistics support required)
